

# College Prep Program

## *What is the College Prep Program?*

The College Prep Program, offered by Woodland Community Development Corporation, is a free ten-week SAT test prep course for Camden City & Camden County 11th graders. The program prepares students to take the SAT test and gives parents and students valuable information about financial aid and college admissions.

## *What does the program provide to students?*

- ◆ 10 SAT test prep classes including 4 practice tests administered by Kaplan Test Prep
- ◆ Kaplan Test Prep study guides and materials
- ◆ Workshops for parents and students on financial aid and college admissions

## *Who is eligible to participate?*

- ◆ Students must be in 11<sup>th</sup> grade
- ◆ Must be eligible for free or reduced lunch
- ◆ Must have taken or are currently taking Algebra and Geometry
- ◆ Must have transportation to get to the UMDNJ Stratford Campus for the classes
